

Cruise ancient waterways, hike to magnificent waterholes, discover the Ord River Valley and enjoy an exclusive dining experience at a fragrant sandalwood plantation. Revealing rugged red cliffs, cobalt blue waters and vast pastoral leases, this outback journey also provides opportunities for observing teeming wildlife, and relaxing while taking in a magnificent Cable Beach sunset in Broome.

Day 1. Fri 12 June 2020 D TOWNSVILLE - BRISBANE - DARWIN

Let's begin our adventure, as we travel to Darwin via Brisbane. Our tour host will meet you at the airport in Brisbane.

Darwin, Australia's tropical capital, is vibrant but easygoing. We take an afternoon tour of the city, then enjoy a Welcome Dinner this evening with our fellow travellers.

Day 2. Sat 13 June 2020 B DARWIN

After breakfast, we enjoy a free day in Darwin to explore at our leisure. We will immerse ourselves in Darwin's rich history including ancient Aboriginal Dreamtime stories, the pioneering spirit of the early settlers, survival stories of World War II, the bombing of Darwin and Cyclone Tracy.

You may wish to indulge your taste buds by sampling Darwin's fabulous food, inspired from the land, incorporating fresh local produce such as mud crab, barramundi, Kakadu plum, lemon myrtle, and even green ants.

Alternatively, if you have yet to visit Darwin and the surrounds, then the optional tour of Kakadu National Park Explorer is highly recommended. Join a local guide for a cruise on the famous Yellow Water Billabong, whilst you search for saltwater crocodiles and marvel at the colourful birdlife.

After a lunch stop at Nourlangie Rock, this optional tour will see your guide lead a walk to view ancient Aboriginal rock art, before returning to Darwin.

Day 3. Sun 14 June 2020 B L D DARWIN - KATHERINE (via LITCHFIELD NATIONAL PARK)

This morning, we head to the Top End's must-see Litchfield National Park, home to several stunning waterfalls that cascade into

crystal clear pools, iconic magnetic termite mounds and clusters of weathered sandstone pillars at the Lost City. After a picnic lunch, take a swim under the falls and relax in the waterholes of Florence Falls and Wangi Falls (weather permitting).

We continue on to Katherine and enjoy dinner tonight at our hotel.

Day 4. Mon 15 June 2020 B D KATHERINE

This morning we venture into Nitmiluk National Park, where a tranquil cruise along the spectacular Katherine Gorge will allow us to sense the spirituality of the land.

Catch glimpses of wildlife and learn about the history and culture of the local traditional owners, the Jawoyn people.

This afternoon, we will be entertained at the Katherine Outback Experience. We will watch and learn how young horses and working dogs are trained for life on the land, before enjoying the Katherine Outback Experience long table dinner.

Day 5. Tue 16 June 2020 B KATHERINE - KUNUNURRA

Watch the landscape transform dramatically as we journey across vast pastoral leases and Aboriginal homelands and cross the border into Western Australia heading to Kununurra.

Along the way, we pause at the historic Durack Homestead, built in 1895. During the pioneering years, the Durack family home became known far and wide as one of the social gathering places of the East Kimberley.

Later, marvel at spectacular scenery as we cruise along the Ord River, which supports an abundance of native fish, birds and marsupials. Experience a magical sunset over the water before our arrival in Kununurra.

Day 6. Wed 17 June 2020 B D KUNUNURRA

Today we can choose between two experiences. You may like to take an early-morning scenic flight over the spectacular beehive-shaped towers of the Bungle Bungle Range. Alternatively a full day 4WD tour of the Bungle Bungles may appeal to you. Otherwise, we have the day to explore Kununurra at our leisure.

This evening, we dine on locally-grown produce at a privately hosted 'Be My Guest' Dinner in the heart of Kununurra's sandalwood plantations.

Day 7. Thu 18 June 2020 B KUNUNURRA - EMMA GORGE

This morning, we take a guided tour of the Ord River Rum Distillery before travelling down the Gibb River Road to Parry Lagoons Nature Reserve (weather permitting), an important water bird feeding and breeding

We make our way to Emma Gorge for our two night stay in an oasis of native pandanus and palms at the foot of the red-hued Cockburn Ranges in the El Questro Wilderness Park. At Emma George Resort we will sleep to the soothing sounds of the local wildlife surrounding us.

Day 8. Fri 19 June 2020 B D EL QUESTRO

We will awake to the calls of native birds, and after a hearty breakfast, explore El Questro Wilderness Park. Afterward, we will cruise on Chamberlain Gorge, an extensive waterhole fringed by tropical vegetation and soaring escarpments.

This afternoon, we will enjoy free time, perhaps taking a dip in the pool, relaxing with a good book on our cabin's verandah, or taking a hike to Emma Gorge for a dip in its crystal-clear waterhole.

Tonight, we will enjoy a buffet dinner with wine at the resort.

Day 9. Sat 20 June 2020 B L D EMMA GORGE - HALLS CREEK

Today, we will join a local Indigenous guide for a tour of the famous Argyle Diamond Mine, the world's largest source of coloured diamonds.

After lunch, we continue south to the historic town of Halls Creek on the northern edge of the Great Sandy Desert and Tanami Desert.

Dinner is included at the hotel tonight.

DAY 10. Sun 21 Jun 2020 B L D HALLS CREEK - FITZROY CROSSING

Today, we travel on to the remote township of Fitzroy Crossing. We will stop en route at Halls Creek to visit an art gallery with a chance to meet Indigenous artists. A tasty lunch is included at the lodge.

This afternoon, we will cruise with a local guide through magnificent Geikie Gorge, watching for freshwater crocodiles, fruitbats and wallabies as the 30 metre walls of the gorge tower above us.

Dinner is included at the hotel tonight.

DAY 11. Mon 22 June 2020 B D FITZROY CROSSING - BROOME

We travel through spectacular landscapes today on the way to the former pearling outpost of Broome. Upon arrival, our Driver Guide will take us on a tour of the town, visiting nearby Gantheaume Point, whose

rugged red cliffs rise in stark contrast to the cobalt blue waters.

This evening, let's relax with a drink while the sun sets over the Indian Ocean.

DAY 12. Tue 23 Jun 2020 B L D BROOME

Today, we take a visit to Willie Creek Pearl Farm, a 5 hour tour including lunch. We will uncover the history, mystery and story of pearling and Broome. Experience the beauty of the Willie Creek Pearl range and discover more about their commercial pearling operations.

This afternoon is at leisure for us to enjoy a stroll along the pristine sands of Cable Beach and swim in its turquoise waters or wander through Chinatown and shop for pearls.

Alternatively, an optional experience is available to enjoy a full-day Horizontal Falls Seaplane excursion.

This evening, we will sit back and share our stories from our amazing adventure as we enjoy a sunset drink and Farewell Dinner at the hotel.


DAY 13. Wed 24 Jun 2020 B BROOME - PERTH - BRISBANE -TOWNSVILLE
