DAY 1. Fri 4 Sep 2020 TOWNSHILL - BRISBANE

Let's begin our journey to Brisbane for our overnight stay at Brisbane Airport accommodation. Our tour host will meet us on arrival.

DAY 2. Sat 5 Sep 2020 BRISBANE - JOHANNESBURG

This morning we check in at Brisbane International Airport for our flight to Johannesburg. Upon arrival, we make our way to our airport accommodation for an overnight stay.

DAY 3. Sun 6 Sep 2020 B D JOHANNESBURG - VICTORIA FALLS

Our journey through this re-emerging country begins today as we fly from Johannesburg to Victoria Falls, Zimbabwe. Upon arrival at Victoria Falls Airport we will be met by our driver and taken by private road transfer on the 20 minute drive to Ilala Lodge.

Offering distinguished accommodation with gracious and secluded ambience, the décor evokes a bygone era of adventure and discovery. The elegant hotel is close to the Falls and town centre, and borders the National Park. Wildlife is often seen on the lawns as well as the spray from the Falls themselves.

This evening, experience a private Raikane Sunset Cruise and Dinner on board a small luxury cruise boat. This boat is small enough to explore the quieter channels of the Zambezi River where we have more chance of seeing fantastic birdlife and wildlife.

After the Sunset Cruise we will enjoy an exceptional dining experience at the Lookout Café before returning back to Ilala Lodge.

DAY 4. Mon 7 Sep 2020 B D VICTORIA FALLS

This morning is at leisure, it is an easy walk to see the magnificent Victoria Falls (entrance fee USD\$30) or you may like to relax in our resort or explore the town.

As one of the Seven Wonders of the World, Victoria Falls is a truly spectacular sight. A natural phenomenon, Victoria Falls is an immense curtain of water cascading over 100m. Around 550 million litres flow over the edge every minute and, at peak flow, this increases to 750 million litres. Around the Falls is a rainforest sustained by the spray of the Falls with some plant species rarely found elsewhere in Zambia or Zimbabwe. 75% of the falls are viewable from Zimbabwe and 25% from Zambia. At the height of the dry season the flow on the Zambia side is less.

This afternoon, we are collected from our hotel and transferred to the Stanley & Livingstone Private Game Reserve for our night game viewing experience and dinner.

The night game drive is a great opportunity to see nocturnal animals, a very special experience. After your game drive, delight in a bush dinner before returning to your hotel. The Victoria Falls Private Game Reserve is a Big 5 Safari destination; lions, elephants, buffaloes, leopards and rhinoceroses can all be seen. The savannah is full of wildlife and

apart from the Big 5, giraffes, waterbucks, zebras and sables all regularly roam across game-vehicle paths.

The Victoria Falls Private Game Reserve is recognised as an Intensive Protection Zone for the black rhinoceros and since implementing a Black Rhinoceros Monitoring and Breeding Program, the population has flourished to the point that they have been able to supply black rhinoceroses to other intensive protection zones for restocking.

DAY 5. Tue 8 Sep 2020 B D VICTORIA FALLS, ZAMBIA

Today, we have a second opportunity to view Victoria Falls and its unspoiled grandeur from the Zambian side (admission is approximately USD\$30). It is a 3km walk around the falls stopping at many view points along the way.

After the Falls walk, there is free time to shop and have lunch (own expense). Alternatively you might take the opportunity for a helicopter flight over the Falls or experience an animal encounter. You may want to tour Livingstone Island tour where the falls flow right beneath you.

This evening, we are collected from the hotel for our luxury Bushtracks Express rail experience. The train will travel across the iconic Victoria Falls rail bridge to Jafuta Conservancy Siding, where a 5 course gourmet dinner will be served.

After dinner, the train will depart for its journey back to Victoria Falls Station before you are transferred back to your hotel.

DAYS 6-8.

Wed 9 - Fri 11 Sep 2020

HWANGE, NEHIMBA SAFARI LODGE

Our journey continues as we make our way, by private transfer, to Victoria Falls Airport, where we board our light aircraft to take us to Giraffe Springs Airstrip. Flying time is approximately 60 minutes. Upon arrival we are taken by road to Nehimba. Transfer time is approximately 20 minutes

Hwange has always been renowned for its incredible diversity of wildlife and, to this day, it boasts more varieties of mammal and bird species than any other Zimbabwean National Park, in particular its 44,000 strong elephant population.

During our stay, we enjoy expertly guided safari activities and game drives each morning and afternoon, as well as the opportunity for walking safaris.

DAYS 9-11.

Sat 12—Mon 14 Sep 2020

LAKE KARIBA, BUMI HILLS SAFARI LODGE

After transferring to Hwange Airport (3 hours with possible game viewing) we take our light aircraft transfer to Bumi Hills.

Situated above the lake, our activities at Bumi Hills include morning and afternoon game drives, fishing and canoeing on the lake and the opportunity for cultural visits.

During our stay we take part in expertly guided safari activities and game drives each morning and afternoon.

DAYS 12-14.

Tue 15—Thu 17 Sep 2020

MANA POOLS, NYAMATUSI CAMP

Today we travel by light aircraft from Bumi Hills to Dandawa airstrip in Mana Pools. Flying time is approximately 30 minutes.

Mana Pools is situated on a river, and we take the opportunity to not only join game drives but canoe and walking safaris as well.

This area boasts wildlife sightings that include elephant, kudu, sable antelope, zebra, wildebeest, gemsbok, the rare and endangered roan antelope, buffalo, lion, leopard, hyena, and many other wildlife species.

DAY 15. Fri 18 Sep 2020

MANA POOLS - HWANGE - JOHANNESBURG - SYDNEY - BRISBANE

We commence our journey home today with a light aircraft transfer to Harare Airport. Flying time is approximately 1.5 hours. We then fly to Johannesburg and then onto Brisbane, via Sydney.

DAY 16. Sat 19 Sep 2020

Our flights see us arrive late into Brisbane where we will clear customs and immigration before making our way to our overnight accommodation at the Brisbane Airport.

This morning we check in at the Brisbane Domestic Airport for our flight to Townsville.



BUSHTRACKS EXPRESS STEAM TRAIN



The Bushtracks Express is an indulgent luxury fine dining experience going back in time to the age of romantic steam train travel. The rejuvenated train jaunts onto the famous Victoria Falls Bridge which was built by Cecil Rhodes in 1905. He wanted a crossing “at the point where the spray from the falls would fall on the train carriages crossing the bridge.”



A red carpet will lead us to the train and the locomotive will be ‘in steam’: the perfect photographic

opportunity. The train will depart Victoria Falls Station and chuff its way through the Victoria Falls Game Park to the border. The train will pause at the border so a ‘general declaration’ can be given by the train guard to the immigration authorities and then continue to the bridge. After arrival on the bridge guests may alight from the train for some tremendous photo opportunities of Victoria Falls, the train, the bridge and the sunset.

EXPLORING AFRICA

WHAT TO EXPECT ON SAFARI

No two safaris are the same. Typically, we rise at dawn and, after a refreshing coffee, depart on our morning game drive. Early in the morning is when the animals are at their most active. As we will be travelling during the dry winter months, wildlife will be easier to spot since waterholes become a place for animals to gather and thinned vegetation assures they are more easily seen. Bright skies are common and rain is scarce.

After the morning game drive, we return to our property for a revitalising breakfast and then take the opportunity to relax and enjoy the facilities during the day. After lunch, we enjoy an afternoon game drive as the animals rise from their siesta to drink, eat and hunt.

Sunset doesn't mean our day is over, or the adventure has to stop. As the sun sinks below the horizon, we will find ourselves with a refreshing drink in our hand as we witness the sun burning the sky red, pink and orange. As a herd of elephants come down to the waterhole for a drink, we will be still and reflect on our day in the wild. The first stars appear, and the sky seems bigger than it does in the rest of the world. When we return to our lodge we celebrate with our friends. We enjoy a delicious meal after a long day of adventures this is just what we need to refuel. We will listen to the stories of our fellow travellers as they describe their close encounters with wildlife on their game drives, or sit by the campfire, or the bush television as its sometimes referred to, it is the perfect way to end your day.

Safaris, sunsets, dinner and drinks, campfires, night excursions and beautiful views. After such an adventurous day, we need a soft pillow and a warm bed to rest our bodies. Reset and refresh our exhausted senses in luxury and rest easy knowing that we will get to do it all again tomorrow.

Important Climate Information

- We will be travelling during the dry winter months
- May–September is the best time to visit Victoria Falls
- Mosquito numbers are very few, so Malaria risk is minimal
- There will be very little humidity and the temperature will average 25°C
- As the climate will be dry, it will be a little dusty
- Mornings can be cooler, so a fleece, scarf and gloves are recommended

Important Luggage Information

- There is a strict restriction on our Charter light aircraft transfers. Luggage is restricted to 15kgs per person in checked luggage and 5kgs hand luggage due to limited space available for storage in regional aircrafts. This includes photographic equipment and hand luggage. Only soft bags (duffle style) will be accepted, rather than hard Samsonite type suitcases.
