

Day 1. Wed 26 August 2020 D TOWNSVILLE - BRISBANE - VANCOUVER

Let's begin our journey to Vancouver, via Brisbane. Our tour host will meet us at the airport in Brisbane. Upon arrival at Vancouver International Airport, we will be met and transferred to our hotel.

This evening we will enjoy a Welcome Dinner at a local restaurant.

This afternoon, we will make our way to the spectacular mountain top of Grouse Mountain. We will visit the Wildlife Refuge to see the Birds in Motion demonstration and so much more.

Day 3. Fri 28 August 2020 B D VANCOUVER

Vancouver is one of the most ethnically diverse cities in Canada. Today, we will have the opportunity to explore the city at our leisure. Shop till you drop, enjoy a coffee, see the sights. There is so much to do we will be spoilt for choice.

This evening, we will enjoy a Gastronomic Gastown Food Tour. We will make our way to Gastown, Vancouver's oldest neighbourhood laden with iconic restaurants, quirky pubs, and historic spaces.

Day 4. Sat 29 August 2020 B D VANCOUVER - EMBARK CRUISE

Day 7. Tue 1 September 2020 B L D JUNEAU

Today, we will explore Alaska's Capital, Juneau. Located on one of the largest wilderness areas in the United States, Juneau offers many opportunities to view wildlife and landscapes including glaciers.

Sit and gaze at the majesty of "The Great One" from the Lodge's treehouse, designed and built by Pete Nelson of Animal Planet's Treehouse Masters.

Day 15. Wed 9 September 2020 ANCHORAGE

This morning, we will take in our final views of the mountains, before we transfer by motorcoach to Anchorage. Failure to do so may result in the termination of your travel arrangements without any liability on the part of Hosted Journeys. Hosted Journeys reserves the right at its discretion to exclude from a tour, or to terminate the travel arrangements during the course of the tour without refund, of anyone who:
- is unable to cope with the requirements of coach travel – this includes embarking and disembarking 4-6 steps that are approximately 30 centimetres high, at each stop of the coach,

- which, on some tours, is at least 8 times per day may need services or facilities that are not available
- fails to comply with the reasonable instructions of Hosted Journeys personnel
- engages in illegal or undesirable behaviour or interferes with the enjoyment of or jeopardises the safety of other participants

Anyone so excluded will be required to disembark at a safe public location, transport from which will be wholly their responsibility. You agree that Hosted Journeys is released from all liability for, and you agree not to hold Hosted Journeys responsible for, termination of your travel arrangements in accordance with the previous condition, or any decision made by Hosted Journeys or by any service provider who refuses to provide you with special accommodation facilities or services that are not available or who refuses to carry you by reason of any disability or medical condition. Any changes to health, mobility and fitness must also be reported to Hosted Journeys as soon as possible and prior to departure

Claims & Complaints:
