**Day 1. Sat 5 December 2020
TOWNSVILLE - BRISBANE - PRAGUE**

Let's begin our journey to Prague. Our tour host will meet us at the airport in Brisbane.

**Day 2. Sun 6 December 2020 D
PRAGUE**

Upon arrival into Prague, we will be transferred to our hotel.

This evening, we will enjoy a Welcome Dinner to get to know our fellow travellers.

**Day 3. Mon 7 December 2020 B
PRAGUE**

After breakfast, we will meet our local guide for an in-depth sightseeing tour of Prague. We will begin our tour of this fascinating city with a visit to the striking Cathedral of Saint Vitus and its brightly decorated houses cut into the arches of the castle walls. We will also visit Prague's hugely impressive Hradcany Castle, which covers over seven hectares and is the largest ancient castle in the world.

This afternoon, we will enjoy some free time for lunch before we explore our first Christmas market. The Prague City Christmas Markets are the most impressive in the country. The main market, located in the old town square, lights up the city and brings locals and tourists together in this truly magical winter wonderland.

Your senses will be delighted with many market stalls consisting of brightly decorated wooden huts stocked with local handicrafts and traditional Christmas treats. Items on display will include ceramics, jewellery, wooden toys, scented candles, Christmas tree ornaments, puppets and dolls. There is all manner of local food and drink available and much of it is prepared fresh at the markets.

Dinner tonight will also be at leisure with a wide array of culinary delights to choose from in this fantastic city.

**Day 4. Tue 8 December 2020 B D
PRAGUE & KUTNA HORA**

This morning, we embark on a journey to Kutna Hora. Here, we will visit the elaborate gothic St Barbara's Cathedral and the eerie yet breathtaking Sedlec Ossuary. Located below the Cemetery Church of All Saints, its decor is homage to the macabre, with somewhere between 40,000 & 70,000 skeletons adorning this church of bones.

This afternoon, we will return to Prague and get back into the Christmas spirit, with more leisure time to explore the vibrant Christmas Markets. This evening, we will indulge in a delicious traditional Czech Christmas Dinner.

**Day 5. Wed 9 December 2020 B D
PRAGUE - DRESDEN**

After a leisurely start to the day, we will travel to Dresden. In the afternoon, we will enjoy a sightseeing tour of the city. Once on the verge of destruction from World War II bombing raids, Dresden has since, rejuvenated to be one of the continent's most beautiful and elegant cities. We will see the perfectly manicured Zwinger Palace courtyard, the Semper Opera House, Fürstenzug and the iconic Frauenkirche which takes pride of place overlooking the Christmas Markets. We will also enjoy a guided tour of the Royal Palace including entrance to the Armoury, Turkish Chamber, Riesensaal (Giant's Hall) and the New Green Vault which boasts a stunning collection of over 1,000 gold and silver objects.

Tonight, we will enjoy a group dinner at our hotel and share our stories from the day.

**Day 6. Thu 10 December 2020 B
DRESDEN**

This morning, we visit the wonderful Saxon Switzerland National Park. Enroute, we will stop at a local bakery in Pillnitz for a short stollen cooking demonstration, a classic German Christmas bread, followed by a tasting served with tea or coffee. We will then make our way to the hilltop fortress, Königstein (Kings Stone). This 800 year old impregnable stronghold is perched over sheer cliffs and offers visitors the chance to walk atop the ramparts and explore the ancient wine cellars. It also has a wonderfully handcrafted three metre wide well dropping 152 metres deep! Before heading back to Dresden, our final stop will be the famous Bastei Bridge. Linking a series of rocky towers, it spans rocky gorge and cliffs, offering awe-inspiring views from the numerous lookout points.

This afternoon and into the evening, is the perfect opportunity to explore the Dresden Christmas Markets. The Dresden Striezelmarkt is Germany's oldest Christmas market, operating since 1434. Dresden boasts eleven different Christmas markets across the city. Our tour guide will give us the best hints and tips to make the most of our 'My Time'.

**Day 7. Fri 11 December 2020 B D
DRESDEN, NURNBERG -
ROTHENBURG**

After breakfast, we will travel to the second largest city in Bavaria, Nurnberg. Upon arrival, we will have some free time for lunch (own expense) before being met by a local guide who will take us on a journey back in time with visits to the Nazi Documentation Centre and Rally Grounds, bringing to life the rallies and war crime trials of World War II. We will then finish our tour of Nurnberg on a lighter note at the magical Nurnberg Christmas Market. This market only allows traditional Christmas artefacts to be sold, offering an

authentic taste of Christmas in Bavaria. The atmosphere is enhanced by the smell of mulled wine, roasted chestnuts, sausages and the sounds of music and singing.

This afternoon will see us continue on to Rothenburg ob der Tauber, before today's Bavarian Christmas theme culminates with a delicious dinner prepared at a local traditional Saxon restaurant.

Day 8. Sat 12 December 2020 B ROTHENBURG

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast today, before we have the opportunity to really immerse ourselves in the beautiful city of Rothenburg Ob Der Tauber and its Christmas markets.

Every year, the medieval town of Rothenburg is transformed into a winter fairytale. For over 500 years, advent festivities have been accompanied by a wonderful Christmas market and we will travel back in time as we soak up the history and heritage.

A visit to Rothenburg is not complete without a visit to Käthe Wohlfahrt's 'Christmas Village'. This incredible shop is located in the center of the town, just off the Market Square. Here we will find the largest selection of German Christmas decorations worldwide!

Day 9. Sun 13 December 2020 B D ROTHENBURG - OBERAMMERGAU

Today, we will travel on the 'Romantic Road', a 350km route through the forests

and mountains of Bavaria. Our first stop will be the picturesque town of Füssen, where we will have free time to explore the Gothic Castle and historic town centre. We will then continue on to the nearby village of Hohenschwangau, dominated by the jaw-dropping, world famous Neuschwanstein Castle. Here, we will enjoy a guided tour of the former home of 'Mad' King Ludwig, exploring the King's apartments, state rooms, halls and throne room. King Ludwig of Bavaria is best known for his fantasy castles and eccentric lifestyle.

This afternoon, we will arrive in the village of Oberammergau, famed for its 'Passion Play' performances which have been staged every ten years since the 1600s. This evening, we will enjoy dinner at the hotel restaurant.

Day 10. Mon 14 December 2020 B OBERAMMERGAU

After breakfast, we will take a trip to nearby Garmisch-Partenkirchen, where we will board a funicular train and cross snow laden fields towards the base of the mighty Zugspitze. Here, the train will enter the mountain and wind through tunnels up to Zugspitzeplatt Station, at an altitude of 2,600 metres. We will then continue via cable car, to the summit of the Zugspitze Mountain, Germany's highest peak, at an altitude of 3,000 metres. We will marvel at the unparalleled 360 degree panoramic views of over 400 peaks in Austria, Switzerland, Italy and Germany. We will have free time for lunch (own expense) at the Gipfelalm Rustic Summit Lodge before catching the Eibsee Cable Car back down to the lake and return to the hotel.

Day 11. Tue 15 December 2020 B D OBERAMMERGAU

This morning starts with a guided tour of the extravagant Linderhof Palace. Built by 'Mad' King Ludwig, in rococo style, this architectural wonder blends the idea of a baroque palace and a medieval castle perfectly. Afterwards, we will make a stop at Kloster Ettal, a grand Benedictine monastery and Baroque church with frescoed dome and liquer distillery.

This afternoon, we enjoy a tour of the Oberammergau Passion Play Theatre before enjoying dinner at a local restaurant.

Day 12. Wed 16 December 2020 B OBERAMMERGAU - INNSBRUCK - MUNICH

After breakfast, we will travel to Innsbruck, in Austria's Tyrol, the alpine city famous for its winter sports. On arrival, we will have free time to explore the Christmas markets and enjoy lunch at leisure (own expense).

The festive Christmas markets in Innsbruck entice visitors with delicious punch and local specialties, such as Kiachl - freshly baked farmers' donuts served with sweet or savoury toppings. The medieval streets are filled with the romantic glow of twinkling lights. Traditional Austrian brass bands play out from the towers and advent concerts get visitors in the Christmas spirit.

This afternoon, we will enjoy a guided visit to Swarovski Crystal World, in nearby Wattens, where we will be mesmerised by the sparkling facets, scintillating jewels and glittering figures throughout.

This evening, we will arrive in Munich and check into our hotel, followed by an evening at leisure.

Day 13. Thu 17 December 2020 B D MUNICH

This morning after breakfast, we will meet our local guide for a walking sightseeing tour of Munich's historic centre, followed by free time in the city. Explore the Christmas markets and any number of incredible attractions and sights in Munich.

Tonight, we will enjoy a group Farewell Dinner in one of Munich's fantastic local restaurants.

Day 14. Fri 18 December 2020 B MUNICH - BRISBANE

After breakfast, we will be transferred to Munich Airport to begin our journey home.

Tour Price:

The package price is per person based on twin share accommodation and subject to a minimum amount of 15 passengers booked. Should minimum numbers not be met, we reserve the right to withdraw the departure and a refund of your paid deposit will be offered. Alternatively the tour will proceed as planned however the Tour Host may not travel with the group. Your holiday cost may increase if minimum numbers are not met. Deposits merely hold the reservations and, due to ongoing currency fluctuations, prices cannot be guaranteed until final payment has been made. Hosted Journeys reserves the right to modify program itineraries, included sightseeing and substitute accommodations and transportation at any time due to unforeseen circumstances. In such circumstances, we will do our best to supply comparable services, accommodations and itineraries, and there shall be no refund in this situation.

Special Requests:
